AFP-2800 PCI v6.06.00

Dear Valued Customer,

Version 6.00.00 firmware is now released for the AFP-2800 and AFP-2802 PCI.

This upgrade includes the following changes;

- Added note to isolation wizard window to clarify that if you want to isolate multiple zones, it must have a space after the separation comma.
- Addressed an issue where PCI did not print zone options correctly. Now it shows AVF as well as alarm and latched options.
- Addressed an issue where if you printed a program and save .txt file 1st and followed by saving the pci file, it did not change the file extension back to "pci". As result it did not save any changes to the pci.
- Addressed an issue where a non firmware file could be selected and downloaded to the panel which causes the panel to crash and a blackbox is required to restore operation.
- Addressed a bug where trying to open a configuration file that does not exist would create a fault message but then PCI would lose focus and could not be recovered.
- IntelliQuad sensitivity could be set to more than 6. This was incorrect as the IntelliQuad can only have maximum of 6 sensitivity settings. PCI was changed to set sensitivity to default value of 3.
- Addressed an issue where the AAM wizard could program an input with a script if user selected and input address for the sounder. This would result in a F15 fault for the input module.

Compatibility

- Compatible with all versions of AFP-2800 although it is recommended that all AFP-2800 are upgraded to the latest.
